

Minutes of the Vestry Meeting

July 19, 2021

St. Bartholomew Episcopal Church

6:00pm

Present: Father Steve (Priest in Charge), Betty Rendlesham, Jack Rendlesham (Treasurer), Matt Matthews (Sr. Warden), Toni Tittle, David LePage, Russ Tripi, Heidi Schinko, Cheney Baltz, John Connelly (Jr. Warden) and Stephanie Clark (Clerk).

Opening prayer offered by Betty Rendlesham at 6:00pm.

Priest Report: Father Steve has been providing pastoral care to John Angus, Vinnie and Maisie. Sharon Holmes is living in a nursing home in Beachwood. She is experiencing dementia. She has also lost weight and is bedridden. Parishioners are encouraged to send her a 'get well' card.

Senior Warden Report: Matt Matthews stated that there was not anything new to report.

Junior Warden Report: John Connelly explained that the AED machine's battery was low. Matt Matthews ordered a new battery, which will arrive in September. The AED pads are on back order, and it is unknown as to how soon they will be arriving. Continued scheduled TMCC Clean up in the church every other Thursday. The ice machine is unable to be repaired. A replacement will cost \$1,500. John Connelly and Matt Matthews recommend purchasing bags of ice when needed. Twenty-pound bags cost between \$4.00 and \$8.00. Fluorescent light outside of the church office will be repaired.

Treasurer's Report: For the month of June, operating income was in abundance of \$5,126.47. The church has an additional income of \$35,000 for the year, which is mostly from the mutual funds and the waiver of the PPP loan.

Old Business:

1. Matt Matthews stated that the scouts will post the solar lights as part of a service project.
2. The church picnic will be held in the backyard. Matt Matthews and Cheney Baltz will work on creating a sign to advertise the picnic information. They will also contact the

Mayfield Village police and fire department to let them know that they're welcome to attend.

3. The check has been cashed and parts have been ordered for the front yard sign. Father Steve will be notified when the sign will be installed.
4. Limbs near the circular area in the front of the church should be cut down. Toni Tittle will contact three local landscapers, including Heidi's recommendation of R&J service, to get a quote for landscaping services. Toni will let Father Steve know once she's contacted them.

New Business:

1. If another toilet fails, then it will be replaced.
2. There will be greeters near the front door of the church to welcome parishioners. John Connelly volunteered to be a greeter for a few weeks.
